



SCHOOL YEAR 2026-2027 NOTICE OF NEW SCHOOL YEAR FOR NEW STUDENTS

1.	Bridging Classes	Bridging Classes for new students will be held on August 27 & 28 from 09:30 to 11:30. Students should wear complete sports uniforms and bring a water bottle and stationery for the classes. If the student cannot attend Bridging Classes due to personal reasons, please apply exemption in writing and attach relevant certificates. Please kindly prepare the following documents in advance and submit to the class teacher during Bridging Classes: 1. Original copy of student's proof of residential address, such as water or electricity bill or any leaflet showing student's address (please write down student's name and class). 2. Photocopy of student's Baptismal Certificate (for catholic students only). 3. Original copy of student's Personal Immunization Record (yellow covered) issued by the Macau Health Bureau (please staple a photocopy of student's Macau ID card inside the booklet). If the Personal Immunization Record is lost, no need to apply for reissuance and resubmit. Students, who were not born in Macau, need to submit the health certificate issued by the place of birth. 4. Photocopies of student's ID cards (including Macau ID card and Student ID card). Please refer to the Photocopy Format (1). 5. Photocopies of ID card of parents or guardians. Please refer to the Photocopy Format (2). 6. One photocopy of student's K3 academic transcript.
2	School Uniforms	Our school uniforms can be purchased at Wai Kei Sundry Goods / Seng Wa Hang. Uniforms which are not purchased from the above companies may differ in styles, colours or materials. Any uniforms not meeting our school's requirements might be prohibited. Parents are requested to refer to the School Uniform Guidelines for approved styles.
3	Bank Account	Our school processes all payments and refunds through parents' Bank of China autopay accounts. Parents should follow the guidelines and complete the application of autopay service on Bank of China e-Banking by July 1. For details, please refer to the Guidelines of Autopay Service Application.
4	Student Textbooks	Grade 1 students' textbooks can be purchased at Livraria Wan Tat between July 11-13. Both cash and electronic payment are accepted. Address: Basement, Broadway Centre, No.258 Rua do Compo, Macau *English Section: Parents who need to purchase CL1 Oxford Discover English textbooks or workbooks through Livraria Wan Tat are requested to place their orders and complete payment between July 11-13 directly at the bookstore (No

		overdue order service is available). The books will be given to students at the beginning of the school year. * Parents who choose to purchase Oxford Discover textbooks or workbooks through other channels are reminded to exercise caution to avoid mistakenly buying counterfeit copies. To respect intellectual property rights, our school strictly prohibits the use of counterfeit copies.
5	School Lunch Service	Our school provides Lunch Service which is registered on voluntary basis. The lunch fee per meal is Mop25 and the lunch service fee for School Year 2026-2027 is paid in three installments. Parents can register and pay Mop500 (lunch fee for September) online according to the guideline between June 27 and July 1. Payments submitted are not refundable in case of your child's voluntary withdrawal. For details, please refer to the Payment Guidelines for Lunch Service (New Students). Remarks: * Chinese Section: P1 ; English Section: CL1 * All Grade 1 new students please enter #01 as student's number.
6	After School Care Service	After School Care Service is an optional service and can be registered on voluntary basis. For the convenience of parents who cannot fetch children on time, After School Care Service is provided after school from 14:10 to 19:00. Students are asked to do homework or revision under the tutors' guidance. The service fee for the first semester is Mop4,750 (from September to January, including snack fee). Parents can register for this service during Bridging Classes. Payments submitted are not refundable in case of your child's voluntary withdrawal. For details, please refer to the Notice of After School Care Service For New Students.
7	Opening Ceremony of School Year 2026-2027	School Year Opening Ceremony will be held on Tuesday, September 1 from 09:00 to 11:00. Students should attend the ceremony 10-15 minutes in advance in complete school uniforms and bring a small backpack and stationery. Class distribution for the new school year will be released on our school webpage in late August.
8	Regular Classes	Regular classes will start from September 2 (Wednesday). School time: 08:20 – 12:00 & 13:30 - 16:10 School Lunch and After School Care Services also start from September 2. Leisure Activity: 16:10 – 17:00/17:30 (Registration will take place in early September and lessons start in October)
9	Bad Weather condition	According to the guidelines for tropical cyclones, rainstorm and bad weather condition issued by DSEDJ, our school will take appropriate measures during the period of class suspension. If classes are suspended during class time, parents need not to rush to fetch your children from school and need not to call for inquiries. Our school will release relevant information through eClass and take good care of the students.
10	Others	10.1 All students will take student photos in our school in September. 10.2 eClass account and WeChat Class Group will be opened for use after the Bridging Classes.
